Section 1. Hay, 1st cut, 85% or more alfalfa

Section 2. Hay, 1st cut, at least 85% legume, other than alfalfa

Section 3. Hay, 1st cut, mixed, minimum of 30% each legume and grass

Section 4. Hay, 1st cut, 85% or more grass

Section 5. Hay, 2nd cut

Section 6. Haylage from silo or sealed bale  
(minimum 10 lbs., displayed in a clear bag)
